



## Orientation

All visiting medical students, residents, fellows, and advanced practitioners must complete the general GME Orientation session prior to the start of their scheduled training on any Florida Hospital campus.

Orientation begins promptly at **8:30am**. Day of the week is subject to change depending on holidays and/or department closures. Please contact the GME office to confirm the date and time of your arrival. Report directly to the GME office at the address listed below.

### **Parking/Directions**
